2. The January 2007 indexes were used for this event. The conversion from Index to Handicap has been completed. Men play from the Middle tees (White) with a Course Rating of 72.3 and slope of 132. Ladies play from the forward tees (Red) with a Course Rating of 69.8 and slope of 117.
