TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. USGA rules govern play except as modified by local rules and conditions.
2. The March 2009 indexes were used for this event. The conversion from Index to Handicap has been completed. Men play from the Middle tees (White) with a Course Rating of 72.2 and slope of 134. Ladies play from the forward tees (Red) with a Course Rating of 69.8 and slope of 117.

WINTER RULES.

3. Tournament Prizes will be:
 - Flights: \$40.00, 1st place; \$25.00, 2nd place; \$15.00, 3rd place & CtPins.
 - Blind Bogey: \$15.00, 1st place.
4. Holes #5 and #14 will be our Closest-to-the-Pins.
5. The phone # for Coyote Creek is 408-463-1400.
6. Remember, in case of inclement weather, call the course the morning of the event to confirm whether or not the tournament will proceed. The decision to play will be made early enough to allow all players to make their starting times.

UC GOLF CLUB INFORMATION

1. The entry for the Eddie Reed Match Play is enclosed in this mailing.
2. The Board met in January on several topics, including:
 - The associate club schedule for the upcoming year.
 - The club will introduce a revised GOY points system for the 2009 season. The points will be 10 points for 1st, 6 points for 2nd, 4 points for 3rd, and 1 point for participation. The major tournaments will have double points. The Eddie Reed tournament will carry 2 points for participating, and a total of 20 pts for winning your flight, 12 points for 2nd place, and 8 points each for semi final losers. There will only be a trophy for the winner of GOY, and additionally there will be a cash payout of \$100 for 1st, \$50 for 2nd, and \$25 for 3rd place.
 - Mike Armstrong will be working with UCSFGC on ideas for a perpetual trophy that can be passed back and forth between our respective clubs a la "The Axe"....get ready to play for "The Broken Putter!"
 - It was decided to table discussions of a fall Member Guest tournament until the next board meeting.
