3. The November 2008 indexes were used for this event. The conversion from Index to Handicap has been completed. The Slope for the Blue Tees is 128 (Course Rating: 71.3 – 6,529 yards) and the Slope for the White Tees is 69.8 (Course Rating: 121 – 6,069 yards).
